PROPOSED SPECIAL RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES OF THE LOUISIANA STATE BAR ASSOCIATION FOR DEBATE OF THE RESOLUTION BY THE RULES OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT COMMITTEE PROPOSING CHANGES TO THE RULES OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT CONCERNING LAWYER ADVERTISING IN LOUISIANA

Subject to the standing rules of procedure of the House of Delegates of the Louisiana State Bar Association, Rule VI Debate

- A. The following shall be the special rules for debate:
 - 1. Opening statement/overview by Rules of Professional Conduct Committee 10 minutes.
 - 2. Committee will move and explain the rules to be considered 20 minutes.
 - 3. Each amendment presenter 10 minutes.
 - 4. Each other speaker 5 minutes.
 - 5. Closing remarks by presenter of the rules 5 minutes.
 - 6. Closing remarks by Committee on any amendment 5 minutes.
 - 7. Amount of time to close following a motion to cut off debate 2 minutes.
 - 8. Only one level of amendments will be permitted.
 - 9. To be considered, all resolutions proposing amendments must be submitted in writing within thirty days in advance of the House of Delegates meeting.
 - 10. While the amendments to the Rules of Professional Conduct, as set forth in the report of the Rules of Professional Conduct Committee, will be voted upon as considered, the entire report of the Committee, as amended during debate, will be voted up or down at the conclusion of consideration of all amendments.
 - 11. The following motions will be out of order prior to the conclusion of consideration of all recommendations:
 - a. Motion to postpone indefinitely.
 - b. Motion to lay on the table.
 - c. Motion to commit or refer.
 - d. A motion to reconsider the vote on any particular rule will be out of order prior to the conclusion of consideration of all recommendations other than the final vote provided for above.
- B. The Rules of Professional Conduct Committee will be assigned the task of ensuring that any changes that the House adopts are consistently drafted.
