Network, meet other young lawyers or members of the bar, and work on events and committees.

- Continuing Legal Education (CLE) Committee**
Join this committee to help moderate various LSBA YLD Continuing Legal Education seminars, including the LSBA's Bridging the Gap Seminar held each October & May prior to the bar admissions ceremony.
- Diversity/Minority Involvement Committee**
This committee encourages ethnic minority participation in the activities of the Division by partnering with the LSBA on their diversity and outreach efforts.
- High School Mock Trial Competition Committee**
This committee is responsible for working with regional coordinators on local mock trial competitions for high schools throughout the state, and for sponsoring a statewide meet where all local winners compete. The state winner then travels to compete in the National High School Mock Trial Competition.
- Local Affiliates Outreach / Young Lawyers Conference Committee**
The purpose of this committee is to provide local affiliates/ bar associations with resources to coordinate and develop law-related educational projects. For the first time this year, the committee teamed up with the CLE committee to host a Young Lawyers Conference in conjunction with the LSBA Midyear Meeting in January.

- Public Service/Barristers for Boards**
This committee oversees the Barristers for Boards Project, which places young lawyers on nonprofit boards or committees throughout the state. The committee solicits young lawyer participants and organizations from the Louisiana non-profit community (who meet certain criteria); they then conduct "Meet and Greet" sessions to assist in matching young lawyers with non-profit organizations and placing the young lawyer volunteers into available non-profit board or committee positions. The committee also coordinates training sessions for the young lawyer participants with non-profit organizations.
- Public Service/Wills for Heroes**
The Wills for Heroes program is a way for lawyers to support and salute the important work of first responders. Lawyer volunteers provide free wills and other estate documents for first responders and also for their spouses or domestic partners. The LSBA Young Lawyers Division joined the the national Wills for Heroes effort in 2009 and to date has provided hundreds of documents for first responders.
